Mosaic Small Groups

These walk each woman through her sacramental graces, Love Language, Temperament, and help her to develop holy friendships. Once a woman has registered as a Builder, she can login and click our KB logo on top left corner. That will take her to the main page of her Host Parish site. Then she will click Join a Mosaic/Hostess to find a Mosaic Small Group.

A Mosaic Hostess

If she finds there are no open groups or none that accommodate her schedule, she may consider becoming a Mosaic Hostess. This is a Builder who will choose a location, day/time, and welcomes 5-7 Builder-Sisters into community. That’s it. She clicks on Contact Us and in the comment section puts Hostess. The Host Parish Admin will follow up with her.
