## ROPE OF HOPE

God has a future of hope for us, and He desires every human being to be  
grafted into His family.

*“For I know well the plans I have in mind for you—plans for your welfare  
and not for woe, so as to give you a future of hope.” Jeremiah 29:11*

*“I know that the Lord has given you the land, and that dread of you has fallen on us, and that all the inhabitants of the land melt in fear before you. For we have heard how the Lord dried up the water of the Red Sea before you when you came out of Egypt . . . The Lord your God is indeed God in heaven above and on earth below. Now then, since I have dealt kindly with you, swear to me by the Lord that you in turn will deal kindly with my family. Give me a sign of good faith that you will spare my father and mother, my brothers and sisters, and all who belong to them, and deliver our lives from death.” Joshua 2:8-13*

*“Tie this scarlet cord [tiqvah - hope] in the window through which you are letting us down.” Joshua 2:18*

*“Do not forget the Lord, your God, who brought you out of the land of Egypt, that place of slavery.” Deuteronomy 8:14

### THE GIFT OF THE EUCHARIST

We claim the gifts of both communion and community through the power of the Eucharist.

*“God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us.” Romans 5:8 (from the 2nd Reading 6/14/26)*

*“I am the living bread that came down from heaven; whoever eats this bread will live forever; and the bread that I will give is My flesh for the life of the world.” John 6:51 (from the Gospel 6/7/26)*

### SHARE THE HOPE

Jesus' final words urge us to spread His hope and St. Carlo Acutis embraced this call.

*“All power in heaven and on earth has been given to Me. Go, therefore, and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you. And behold, I am with you always, until the end of the age.” Matthew 28:18-20 (from the Gospel 5/17/26)*
